To begin studying on one of our programmes you need to have achieved certain grades at GCSE.

- For **Level 3 Five GCSEs at grade 5+** are needed. This will probably include English and Mathematics. There are also some minimum entry guidelines for individual courses listed in the table below.
- For one of the **Level 2 Pathway** courses learners will need **5 GCSEs at grade 2+** or equivalent.

Please note that if you enrol on one of the Level 2 courses you are signing up for one day per week **Work Experience** and you will also be required to attend resit classes in **English** and **Mathematics**, if you have not obtained a grade "4" in those subjects in Year 11.
