



Exam Results 2017

We are pleased to present our exam results for 2017. The picture is very complex at the moment because the DfE have implemented a vast amount of changes to the exams system in England since 2014. The changes continue and, at present, are only partially phased in. So for Year 11 students, they have 'mix and match' results with numbers (9-1) in English Language, Literature and Maths and letters (A*-G) in all other subject. As you can imagine, transferring that mixed picture into one coherent points score system is challenging. There is also no true comparative data from previous years as the system was different. We have put in data from previous years but it is not comparing like with like. The way the points are tallied has changed in 2017 from the 2016 rationale, which in turn was different to the 2015 system! So from that point of view we are very much in an interim year.

However, we have endeavoured to be open and transparent about our exam results. We have included our provisional Progress 8 score; this is how our students do in their best 8 subjects (divided into 3 categories) relative to their DfE generated targets and relative to how other youngsters in England have fared. The figure for 'All' is a provisional figure for everyone in the year group. The DfE also issue a figure but they only include students for whom they have a KS2 score from Year 6. For Lord Grey School this is at least ten fewer students than the whole cohort. Our 'Internal' data excluded students who are now known as 'outliers'; this includes youngsters who might be school refusers or who were ill during the exam period or who had exceptionally complex emotional and behavioural needs which significantly impacted on their performance. Progress 8 also compares the performance of our Bletchley teenagers with all other 16 years olds in England.

Attainment 8 is a points tally across their best 8 subjects. The Basics is how students have done in Maths and English Language or Literature and it looks at how many students have the new Grade 4 in both subjects. It takes the best score from the two English GCSEs. We are pleased with a 5% rise on last year.

The EBACC tells us what proportion of students have Grade 4 or above in Maths, English Language or Literature, History or Geography, one Foreign Language and two Sciences. Thus it is very stringent because if a student misses the C grade in just one of these subjects, they do not meet the EBACC threshold.

We also enclose all of our post 16 data for our Sixth Form; Year 13 and Year 12. This is a combination of A level data, AS level results, vocational courses at Level 3 outcomes and vocational courses at Level 2 results. GCSE re-sit results for students aged 17 or 18 are also included. Post 16 education in England is also in a state of flux as new A level and vocational course specifications are launched. These have also been phased in over a few years.

As the picture is so complex, please do not hesitate to ask a member of staff if you want anything clarified. I am very proud of this school and its 'Good' status from its last Ofsted inspection. Exam results only tell us a part of the picture – they don't tell the whole story of how Lord Grey develops confident, flourishing and well-rounded young citizens. There is plenty to be proud of in these results. Where they are at target or above, we strive to keep pushing forward and where they are below target, we drill down to consider how we can improve things. We are never complacent about public exam results and constantly strive to live up to our motto of Aspire, Learn, Achieve.
