Dear Parents, Carers and Guardians.

C3 Procedure from week beginning 8th November

Over the last two years, throughout covid, we had modified our C3 behaviour sanction. We removed the after school detention for a C3. Now that we are learning to live with Covid we feel it is important to go back to our clear system of detentions for C3. Students in our student survey last half term have asked us to bring this back as it was such a clear system.

For those students and parents in Years 7 and 8 who are not experienced in the C system in this new 'normal' and for those in Years 9 and above that may have forgotten, our Consequence system is a clear stepped approach to dealing with behaviour.

C1- A verbal warning is given by the teacher.

C2- Behaviour or disruption continues and another warning is given.

C3- Behaviour or disruption continues and the teacher issues a C3. There are some behaviours where a straight C3 is given: wandering out of class without permission, talking in a test or assessment, swearing, physical fight or damaging property. A C3 slip is given for the student to go to another classroom (a Faculty remove room) and an after school 30 minute detention is set.

C4- a period of time in Refocus.

With the stepped approach to behaviour, it means that students have a chance to modify their behaviour as well as clearly understand where their behaviour needs to improve.

From **Monday 8th November**, we are reintroducing the after school detention.

If your child receives a C3 by their teacher, this will be reported on Go4schools. Your child will be expected to attend a 30 minute after school detention the next school day 3.05- 3.35pm in MA09 or MA08 with a member of the Leadership Team. You will be notified by Go4schools that this detention has been set, if you have the Go4schools app you will also be able to see the specificity of the reason for the C3.

In the detention, the class teacher or Head of Faculty will also attend to complete a restorative conversation so a chance to discuss this situation happens and a new start begins.

Failure to attend the C3 detention will lead to another 30 minute detention the following evening and a loss of break and lunch for that day.

If your child receives more than one C3 in a day, they will be escalated to the next sanction which is Refocus till 4.30pm.

We have high expectations of our students and believe in praise as much as holding students into the pace of the Lord Grey Way. We will always seek to praise as much as we hold high standards for behaviour. This is a return to previous procedures as we go back to normal routines.
