1	Make flash cards for the key terms associated with urban and rural processes in the UK.		
2	Create a diagram which highlights how towns and cities are often divided into different zones based on wealth, poverty, ethnicity, and urban function.		
3	Make a poster to show the differences between eco-homes, and sustainable communities.		
4	Write a story which demonstrates how Bletchley town centre has declined as a result of the opening of centres like the Centre:MK and MKOne, and online shopping.		
5	Create a table to demonstrate the positive and negative impacts that sporting effects can have on areas (think about sphere of influence).

6	Make a poster to show the differences between Sydney (a city in a HIC) and Mumbai (a city in a LIC).		
7	Create a storyboard to show the life of somebody working in an informal job in a LIC.		
8	Write a short report outlining the different ways that slums can be improved in LICs.		
9	Where would you prefer to live: London, or Sao Paulo? Explain your choice.		
10	Create a glossary of key terms / flash cards on urbanisation in HICs and LICs.

11	Write a story comparing the life of someone in a HIC with that of someone in a LIC.		
12	Create flash cards on indicators of development.

14	Create a chart showing both positive and negative impacts of globalisation.
