



Arrangements for Year 7 students on the first day of school: Wednesday 4th September 2019

8:30am	For today only, we would like Year 7 students to arrive at 8:30am and make their way to the main hall, where they will be greeted by their Head of House. They will then be collected by a member of their allocated tutor group, who will take them to their tutor base to meet the rest of their group.
8:50am – 9:50am	Your child will take part in a carousel of activities with their tutor group. This will include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the distribution of planners and timetables • a walk of the site, so that Year 7s can begin to familiarise themselves with the layout of the school • finger printing (Biometric system) • the rewards system • discussion of expectations of behaviour • a range of presentations in readiness for the commencement of studies.
9:50am – 10:50am	From period 2, students will begin to follow their timetabled lessons.
10:50am – 11:10am	Break time, where students will have the opportunity to get refreshments and to socialise.
11:10am – 12:10pm	Lesson 3
12:10pm – 12:50pm	Lesson 4 – slightly shorter period, due to an extended lunchtime for Year 7 students.
12:50pm – 1:50pm	Year 7 students will have an extended lunchtime to allow them to become familiar in using the canteen and lunchtime procedures.
After lunch, your child will continue to follow their timetable	
1:50pm - 2:50pm	Lesson 5
2:50pm - 3:15pm	Tutor time – students will meet back in their tutor base to reflect on their first day.
3:15pm	School finishes.

Please note that your child will **not** require a PE kit for the first day. However, they will need the specified writing equipment as listed on the reverse of this schedule. (Please see overleaf).

Thursday 5th September will commence at **8:50am** and students will follow their timetable. Extended lunchtimes will continue for the first few weeks, until your child is fully settled.
