Below outlines the expectations around the Sixth Form Dress Code here at Lord Grey Academy.

Dress Code Preferences

Shirts and Tops

Shirt and tie, polo or other collared top. A smart blouse or top or dress.

Trousers

Formal pair of tailored trousers, chinos or shorts. Black denim jeans.

Skirts and Dresses

A smart dress or playsuit that covers shoulders and back. Smart skirt.

Shoes

A smart formal shoe, plain, predominantly black trainers or canvas style shoe.

Uniform non negotiables

- Ripped trousers or Jeans.
- Blue or badly faded/washed denim
- Hoodies or any hooded items, except a coat.
- Offensive slogans on any clothing
- Leggings, joggers or other sportswear
