Year 9 students select their Guided choices in Year 9. Students select an EBACC subject from either History, geography or Languages.

Students then select a further two options, which may include a second EBACC subject.

Option choices include Art, Music, DT, Child Development, Business studies and Computer Science.

Students will be guided into either Triple Science or Combined science in January 24

Students in year 12 select a pathway of either A Levels, level 3 vocational qualifications or a mixture of both.

Students may choose a Level 2 pathway, which will include resit English and/or Maths, in place of enrichment activities.

Enrichment opportunities include PSG, Sports leaders, EPQ, Journalism and Inspiring Teacher programme.
