<p>Typical Forgetting Curve for Newly Learned Information</p>	<p>Revision Power Hour</p> <p>Step 1 Choose a past paper question or questions which would take 20 minutes</p> <p>Step 2 Revise for 20 minutes on what you need to know</p> <p>Step 3 Do the question and set a timer for 20 minutes</p> <p>Step 4 Mark your answer (s) this will help you think like an examiner, make a note of lost marks and a list of what/where you need to improve</p> <p>Step 5 Get Feedback</p>	<p>Revision Myth</p> <p>Rereading and highlighting texts help - No! These just make you think you are busy and have no impact on memory or revision.</p> <p>The best tools and techniques:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Past Papers with mark schemes ● Good Flash Cards, usable from both sides ● Knowledge Organisers ● Personal Learning Checklists ● Self quizzing tools such as online platforms
Retrieval Practice	Interleaving Practice	Spaced Practice
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Retrieval practice means trying to learn the content you have been taught ● Make a list of all the information you need to know from each topic in a particular subject, Close your book or revision guide and make a quiz. ● Try to recall (retrieve) everything you remember. ● Go back and check what you remember against your answers. ● Repeat, several times, but space the repeats out. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students switch between topics in a subject revision session (15-20 mins per topic) ● 1) ABCD 2) CBAD 3) DACB etc ● Key is to find balance between getting it and moving on ● Proven technique to highlight similarities and differences between topics, link concepts and solve problems ● Students have to have access to a full list of topics
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Little and often v cramming. Little and often overcomes the curve ● Spaced practice is less stressful ● Reduces time ● Review each class (hwk?) ● 1 day after, 1 week after. ● Leave 2-3 days between subjects
