- For **Level 3 five GCSEs at grade 5+** are needed. This will probably include English and Maths. There are also some minimum entry guidelines for individual courses listed in the table on the following page.
- For one of the **Level 2 Pathway** courses learners will need **five GCSEs at grade 2+** or equivalent.

Please note that if you enrol on one of the Level 2 courses you are signing up for enrichment of either **Work Experience** or the **Duke of Edinburgh Award** and you will also be required to attend resit classes in **English** and **Mathematics** if you have not obtained a grade "4" in those subjects in Year 11.
