Activity	Overview
Assembly	The role of the school assembly will be to support the development of Character, Vision and Values , Social Moral, Spiritual and Cultural awareness. Students are expected to enter calmly and sensibly and must be seated in Alphabetical order
SMSC	The personal development of pupils; spiritually, morally, socially and culturally plays a significant part in their ability to learn and interact with the wider world. This session will provide opportunities to develop their own beliefs and awareness, a positive caring attitude towards others an understanding of their social and cultural traditions and an appreciation of the diversity and richness of other cultures.
Register Read Respond	Weekly literacy sessions. Through this session, our aim is to develop reading comprehension, improve vocabulary, build background knowledge and explore big ideas and complex issues
Character	We aim to become an 'Academy of Character'. In this session, students will develop the skills and personal attributes needed to be higher attaining, well rounded individuals with the skills needed to be successful both at Lord Grey Academy and life beyond. At the core of the programme will be our chosen values. This session will combine resources from the Jubilee Centre for Character Development and PIXL's LORIC initiative.
Learn For Success	In this activity, students will embed the necessary skills to be a successful self studying student. Students will develop the use of knowledge organisers and self quizzing. In addition to this, additional quizzes and activities will also feature. For example, there will be a termly quiz as well as whole school numeracy activity.
