English Language	45 minutes	<p>As part of their English Language Self-Study this half term, students will continue to prepare for my formal Speaking and Listening assessment. Students will be submitting drafts of their materials for the S&L assessment to their teacher(s) for feedback and revising and improving of their work.</p> <p>Additionally, students will revise key details and knowledge about Language Paper 2 using the Top Tips document, including both Section A reading and Section B writing. Geography	45 minutes	<p>Changing Places, Changing Economies - Urban and rural processes: every lesson students will carry out daily Do Now activities at the start of the lesson; this is based on prior learning. Students will also have regular assessment points based on GCSE style questions, ranging from short tariff (1, 2 and 4 mark questions) to longer tariff questions (6, 8 and 12 marks). Students need to look at the higher grading criteria, and strive to achieve the highest grade possible for the piece of coursework they are completing.</p> <p>Whilst learning the subject content in preparation for your completion of coursework unit students are expected to complete the self study tasks in google classroom.
