English	<p>Deadline 1: 17th June</p> <p>Task 1: Students will read their Accelerated Reader books for 20 minutes a night, fill in their reading tracker in their knowledge organiser and quiz online: Extra Accelerated Reader Tracking Sheets</p> <p>Task 2: Students will complete all of the common spelling mistakes activities that have been assigned on Seneca. Click on the link here (Your login should be your pnumber gmail address and your usual password. You may have to click on 'log in via google' to get this to work. Once you are logged in you will need to join the class - your class code is jmxlxuz03a and then click on 'assignments').</p> <p>Task 3: Choose ONE of the following tasks to complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● One: Research Marilyn Monroe's life. Why has she been used as a motif in the play? Present your findings as either a poster or a page from her autobiography. Use this video as support: What is an autobiography?● Two: Write an essay or speech explaining whether 'Nature' or 'Nurture' is more important. Persuade your audience to agree with your opinion using persuasive writing techniques. Use this link as support.● Three: Write a guide for students explaining how they can prevent boredom in school. What can they do to liven up the school day?
