Summer uniform

When students return from the half term break the summer uniform policy comes in to effect. In the (hopefully) warmer weather students are no longer required to wear their school jumpers. Students will still need to wear their blazers, although in very warm conditions there will be some flexibility in this. Teachers will allow students to remove their blazers in hot classrooms. Students are expected to have their ties done up properly and tied so that the bottom of the tie reaches the waistband of their skirt or trousers.

Uniform from September 2019

We know that many parents will be thinking about buying new uniform ready for September. There are no major changes being made to the uniform policy from September but any new blazers will now come with the Lord Grey emblem on the pocket. There is no requirement for students with blazers that fit perfectly well to have a new one - the badged ones will be phased in over time. We are also introducing a long sleeved jumper as an optional extra from September for those students who find the tank top and blazer combination not quite warm enough in the winter.

Please note that our policy is very clear that jeans or jeans style trousers are not part of the school uniform. Jeans style means no trousers with jeans style patch pockets on them. Our uniform policy and details of our uniform suppliers can be found on the school website.
